



ZaCSA Spouse / Family Member Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

Scholarship applications are now available for the ZaCSA Spouse/Family Member Scholarship. This scholarship is open to spouses and family members of active duty military or civilians working in the Camp Zama military community (excluding high school students).

Below are some frequently asked questions and answers about this scholarship:

Q. Do I need to be a member of ZaCSA to apply for the scholarship?

A. No; however, we encourage everyone to join ZaCSA.

Q. Do I need to be working on a degree program?

A. Yes, students need to be working towards an associate, bachelor or graduate degree.

Q. Can I use the scholarship for Japanese language classes?

A. Yes, if it's part of your degree program.

Q. Where can I get an application form?

A. Application forms are available at the Camp Zama Education Center, ZaCSA's East Meets West Shop, ACS, or they can be downloaded from the ZaCSA website (www.zacsa.org).

Q. When is the deadline?

A. All materials must be received by the ZaCSA Scholarship Chairperson by 1 February to be considered for the scholarships awarded in May.

Q. I have already received a ZaCSA scholarship but am still working on my degree. Can I apply for another scholarship?

A. Sorry, ZaCSA only awards one scholarship per person.

Q. I'm working towards a degree through an online program; am I eligible to apply for the scholarship?

A. Yes, as long as you are working on a degree program that is offered through an accredited US college or university, you can apply for the ZaCSA scholarship.

Q. My son is a military family member attending college in the US. Is he eligible to apply for the ZaCSA scholarship?

A. Sorry, but this scholarship is intended to benefit spouses and family members living and working on a degree overseas in the Camp Zama community; therefore, your son is not eligible.

Q. Why are high school students excluded from receiving this scholarship?

A. ZaCSA has a separate scholarship that is available to Zama High School seniors. Application forms for that scholarship will be available in early spring. All Zama High seniors are encouraged to apply for that scholarship.
